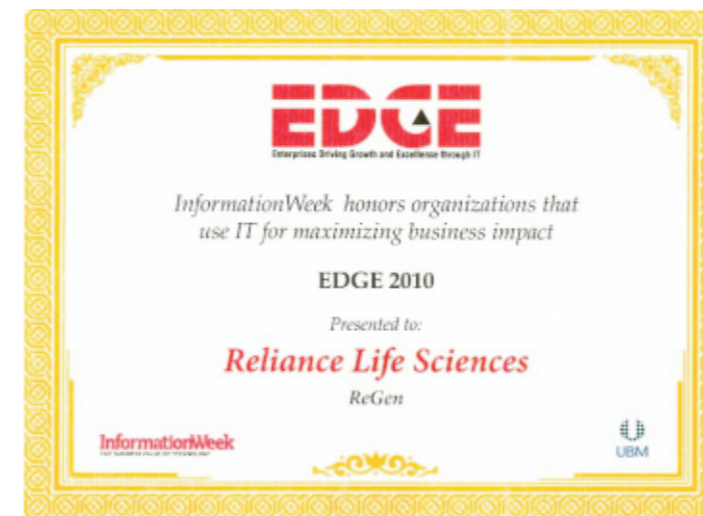


EDGE award for RLS
